The City of Decatur is committed to:

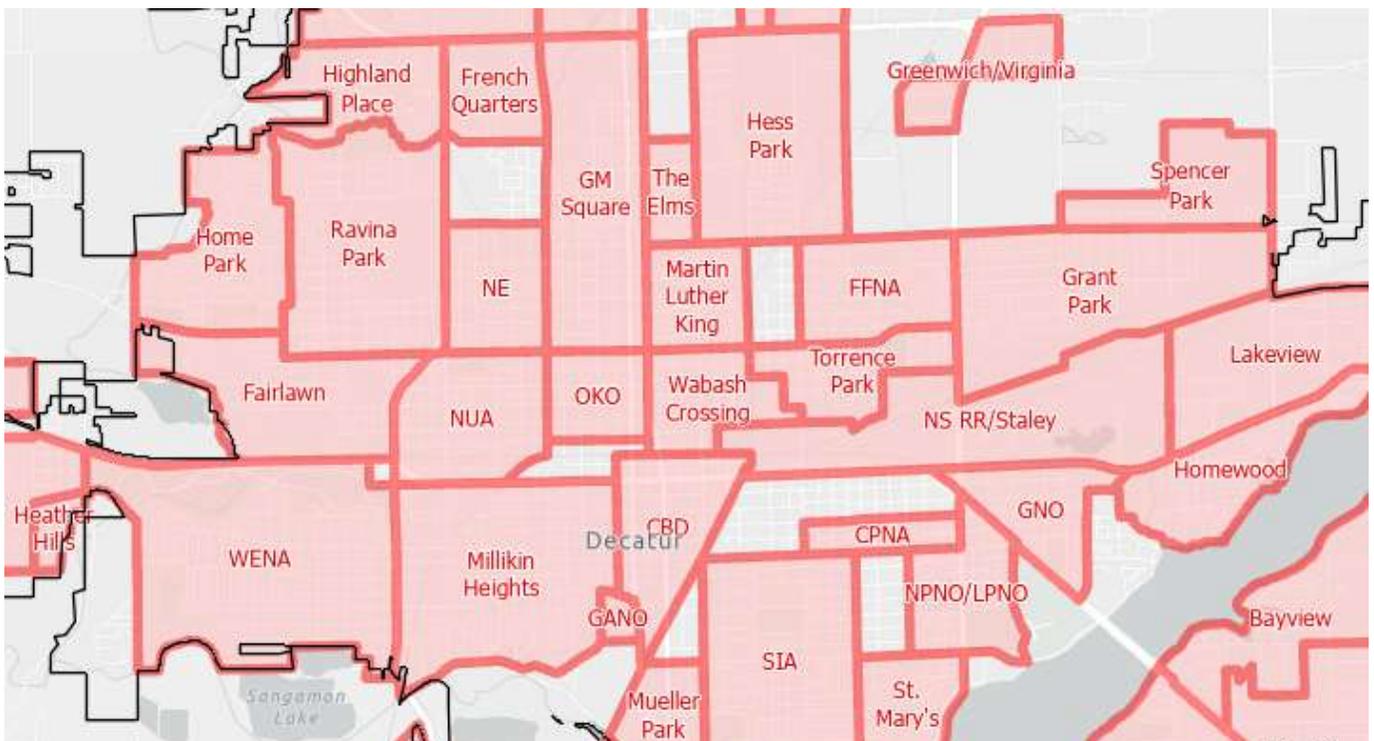
1. **Community Revitalization.**

Beginning in 2019, the City of Decatur conducted a neighborhood conditions survey of our urban core neighborhoods. The data collected in 2019 and again in 2022 allowed the City Council to make strategic decisions about how to prioritize investment in these neighborhoods.

<b>Department</b>	<b>Performance Outcome</b>
Public Works	Monitor safety on Lake Decatur by recording the number of boat accidents and boat OUIs on the lake annually. These will be tracked monthly and compared to the same month in the previous year.
Public Works	Reduce the amount of sediment accumulating in the lake annually.

<b>Department</b>	<b>Performance Outcome</b>
Public Works	Track the incremental changes to the pavement condition index against the capital funds spent and project costs
Public Works	Monitor the City's sanitary sewer system by: Monitor system maintenance by tracking system caused dry weather backups.
Public Works	Meet or exceed the federal and state drinking water standard for turbidity, chlorine, and nitrate. These will be tracked daily by testing the drinking water as it leaves the SWTP.
