AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADOPTED APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF MONIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES FOR CERTAIN FUNDS OF THE CITY OF DECATUR, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2019, City Council passed the Annual Appropriation Ordinance 2019-10 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of several departments and funds of the City of Decatur for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2019, City Council passed Ordinance 2019-253 Appropriating Additional monies for the purpose of defraying the expenses of several departments and funds of the City of Decatur for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to appropriate additional funds for operational expenditures for the City to effect provision of services to its citizens which were not anticipated at the time the City Council adopted Ordinance 2019-10 and Ordinance 2019-253.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DECATUR, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following amounts are hereby appropriated in fiscal year ending December 31, 2019 and set apart within the following designated funds for expenditures as follows:
